MACQUARIE AIRFINANCE DELIVERS A320 TO VOLARIS

DUBLIN, April 21, 2011 – Macquarie AirFinance, global aircraft leasing company based in Dublin, Ireland, announced that it has delivered an IAE V2427-A5 powered Airbus A320-200 aircraft to Volaris in Mexico. The June 2004-model A320, MSN 2204, was delivered to Volaris on 13 April. This is the third aircraft owned by Macquarie Group to be operated by Volaris, the other two being Airbus A319's.

Volaris is a leading low cost carrier that started operations in 2006, offering value fares for leisure and business travelers to a variety of domestic Mexican destinations, as well as several cities in the United States. Volaris operates its fleet of 26 Airbus A319 and A320 aircraft.

Commenting on the transaction, John Willingham, Chief Executive Officer of Macquarie AirFinance, said: "Macquarie AirFinance takes great pleasure in expanding our relationship with our valued customer, Volaris and to be part of the dynamic Mexican air transport industry." Mr. Willingham said.
