Opportunity

In England, 60 per cent of disadvantaged children do not achieve basic qualifications, risking a lifelong struggle to find sustained employment

Actions

ReachOut provides mentoring and positive role models for young people in need. Macquarie staff have provided many years of mentoring, volunteer and fundraising support

73%

high school pass rate among ReachOut participants (compared to 58% national average)

99%

ReachOut participants in education, employment or training six months after leaving school

£390,000
